

Media Players and More DTV-002 Single Tuner Media Player

Firmware Upgrade Instructions

1. Download the firmware file from this web page
<http://www.mediaplayersandmore.com.au/firmware.php>
2. The file you require is
http://www.mediaplayersandmore.com.au/docs/DTV002/DTV002_20090427.rar
3. Unzip the file using Winzip or equivalent and copy the .img file to a USB stick.
4. Connect the USB stick to a USB Host port at the rear of the Media Player.
5. This img file needs to be copied to the internal hard drive. Goto Browser- File Copy, select copy from USB, copy to HDD then find the file on the USB stick and highlight it then press copy.
6. Turn on the Media Player and navigate to Setup then System, then scroll down past the end of the screen to S/W Update.
7. Click on update and then it should start after a few seconds. You will get the Media Centre screen then a basic light blue screen showing a timeline bar.
8. When this is done the unit will reboot automatically. You will need to re-enter some settings and the nthe screen will adjust back to normal.

Additional Software Installation Instructions

Instructions for installing your own hard drive and additional software.

1. Unscrew the 4 screws at the rear of the unit. Gently take off the back plate. Then slide the case off towards the back of the unit.
2. You will see a section where the hard drive need to be placed. Undo the silver screw and slide out the plastic locking bar.
3. Slide the SATA hard drive in so the hard drive lines up with the male connection and then screw in the locking bar.
4. Slide the case back on. Note make sure you line up the slots and that the rear of the case has a slight recess and thats at the rear. If it doesn't slide in easily, its around the wrong way.
5. Place the back plate on and screw the 4 screws back in.

7. The file you require is

8. Unzip the file using Winzip or equivalent and copy the 4 files to a USB stick.
9. Connect the USB stick to a USB Host port at the rear of the Media Player.
10. Turn on the Media Player and if its a brand new hard drive the unit will sense this and start the format options. Normally I select 4 hours as the maximum buffer and then enter.
11. After the formatting od the hard drive, it will install the 4 files on the USB stick and then restart automatically and its done.

Instructions for just installing the additional software to an already formatted (with time shift buffer) hard drive.

2. The file you require is

3. Unzip the file using Winzip or equivalent and copy the 4 files to a USB stick.
4. Connect the USB stick to a USB Host port at the rear of the Media Player.
5. Turn on the Media Player and navigate to Setup then System then Info. You will see 4 options. Click on the first one and then install. After it installs, select it again and click in run. It should then change to "running".
6. Do the same for the next 2 options. The last option will not need to be set to running.
7. Then you can refer back to the manual for the rest of the setup options.
